Bless all the children and keep them safe. Hear us when we humbly and thankfully pray to you.



What does it feel like to be born again?




Memorize today's Verse

Soon the pad of feet announced the approach of another person. He was a Levite--a man who helped the priests at the temple.




Finally a Samaritan man came along. Jewish people hated Samaritans.




At a roadside inn, the Samaritan took care of the man all night.



In the morning he paid the innkeeper to care for the traveler until he was well again.




The lawyer answered, "His neighbor was the Samaritan who showed mercy."


